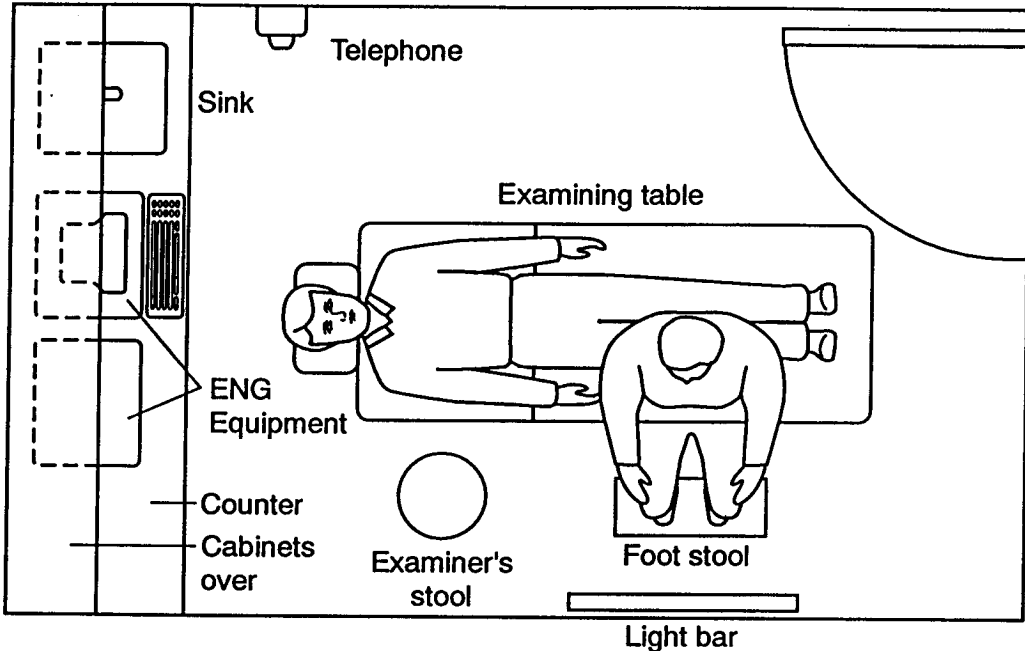


ENG Testing Room

A room suitable for conducting ENG tests is shown below. The room is 8 feet wide and 12 feet long. The examining table is placed in the center of the room. A counter and cabinet are placed along the back wall to hold ENG equipment, a sink, and supplies. There is enough space between the patient's head and the counter so the examiner can move around the patient. There is a telephone within easy reach for summoning help, if needed. Testing begins with the patient in the sitting position facing a light bar (or other visual display) for the saccade, gaze, tracking, optokinetic, and the first part of the position test. Then the patient lies down for the remaining part of the position test and the caloric test.
